West Ave is now State St. (County Road # 611). Continue on State St keep right and go under Route # 440 to Pulaski Ave. in Perth Amboy which is first right after Route # 440 and Portuguese Sporting Club is on the left.

Turn left on **Cortland St.** (La Asuncion Catholic Church is on right side). Our Lady Hungary is ¼ mile down this street on the right after Wayne St.

Parking lot is in the back of Church on Catherine St.

IT'S CONVENTION TIME

I'M BACK

The State is planning on having the Convention in Wildwood in May. We again will be having the same motel, "The Waters Edge Motel". The dates of the convention are Thursday, May 13, Friday, May 14 and Saturday, May 15 with check-out on Sunday, May 16, 2021. Approximate cost of rooms will be \$220 for 2 nights (Friday and Saturday) and \$310 for 3 nights (Thursday, Friday and Saturday). There will be a \$10 per person/per night fee for more than two people in a room. This fee will be paid to the motel upon check-in.

I have been reluctant to collect the \$100 deposit per room until NOW. Please pay promptly. Unfortunately, the balance on all rooms will be due in April. If \$100 has been paid, the balance for April will be \$120 for 2 nights and \$210 for 3 nights. If no deposit has been paid, the total cost in April will be \$220 for 2 nights and \$310 for 3 nights.
